ArtShop 2010 VISUAL ARTS CLASSES:

YOU ARE AUTHOR AND AN ILLUSTRATOR: Write and illustrate a book! Veteran instructors, **Liz Mowrey** and **David Groth**, offer writing tips and teach techniques of drawing and illustrating in this fun week in which each participant creates a book of their own. Students must be going into **grades 4-8**. Join the Fun!

CARD MAKING: How do you tell someone you care about them? For any occasion, or no occasion at all, creating something for someone shows you care. In this class, spend the week creating cards for all occasions. Next time you are invited to birthday party or special event, or if you just want to tell someone you care, you will be able to give a one-of-a-kind card made exclusively by you! Join **Jessica Hammond** to make the cards and a special keepsake container to store all of your unique creations.

CARTOONIVERSITY: A unique opportunity to work with professional Cartoonist, **Jeff Johnson** from the Seattle area learning the basic elements of cartooning: character development, expressions, action/movement, layout, exaggeration, etc. through a series of fun, creative projects in a positive, encouraging environment.

PLAYING WITH DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHS:

Would you like to change the look of bad photos, learn to crop them or create new images from them? Creatively change photographs with Photoshop Elements and learn to create your own PowerPoint show of your photos. Your guide to this digital world is **Don Watson**. Digital Photography has long been his passion and hobby. He will help you through the digital maze and you'll have fun doing it.

GLASS FUSION: Students in **grades 4-8**, create your own fused glass necklaces, earrings, magnets, mirror, ornaments, sun catcher, or wind chimes with glass artist, **Kim Huender**. Learn about different types of glass, how to cut and put pieces together to have beautiful and functional art pieces.

JEWELRY DESIGN!: Learn design basics and how to use your imagination to create some amazing things like necklaces, earrings, bracelets and much more. Make these beautiful creations with glass, silver, shells, paper and fresh water pearls. Sharing and designing ideas with guidance from **Jan Hallmark**.

MOSAICS: Create your own design using porcelain tiles, ceramic tile pieces and glass beads. Take home your mosaic trivet and mosaic wall hanging. Working with artist **Jan Wilhelmi**, the class will design a community mosaic art piece in addition to their own work. Advanced mosaic students will choose from mosaic combined with an etched mirror, cement cast mosaic or an exterior mosaic on cement backer.

MUD WORKS!: Instructor, **Carol Uptagrafft**, will help you get your hands dirty! Learn pinch, slab and coil methods while working on hand built projects. Learn glazing techniques and tiles too.

PAPIER MACHE SCULPTURES: Build an animal, a giant cheeseburger or make up your own animal instead. Build the framework and create with papier mache and then paint with bright colors of tempera. Then sit back and smile as people marvel at your unique sculpture. **Liz Mowrey** encourages creativity!

RENEGADE PRINTMAKING: Renegade Printmaking will show you how to put your own repeatable designs on just about anything. **Keith Miller** will teach you to make your own stencils and to print your own posters, stickers and even t-shirts. All using things you can find lying around your house.

SCRATCHBOARD ART: **Bob Brunn** will teach you the method to engrave your own design in a Scratchboard to reveal your picture, resembling a beautiful etching.

SILK PAINTING: **Kim Torgerson** teaches this fun class. Learn the technique of painting on silk with brilliant color dyes. Silk fabric with an artistic look.

IN THE STYLE OF THE MASTERS: You will explore a variety of painting styles inspired by famous artists of the past. **Bill Burch** will help you recreate the styles of Picasso, O'Keefe, Escher, Van Gough, Seurat & Pollack.

WEAVE A PAINTED WARP RUG or HANGING: Learn to weave a picture! Looms will be constructed; warps will be your canvas to paint on with fabric paints and dyes. The weft (yarn and/or fabric woven across) will create your unique design to display as a picture or be made into a small rug. Embellishments can be added to your art work to enhance your design. You will learn to weave and express yourself with fiber artist **Deborah Loy**.

ArtShop 2010 PERFORMING ARTS CLASSES:

BELLY DANCE: You will love the control you will learn to have over your body while getting fit. **Abeer Abdo** offers this exciting cultural living art class all the way from Jordan. It is designed to teach you basic belly dancing moves, learn about Middle Eastern culture and get you involved in a fun hobby that nurtures self-expression, celebration and fantasy. Join us on stage for a special performance.

CLOWNING AROUND: Have you discovered your “inner clown” yet? **Terry Barnard “Corky the Clown”** helps you develop your own clown personality and special routine. Try your hand at magic, face painting and balloon animals. Join the clown troupe on stage for a special performance!

DO YA’ WANNA’ ACT?: Happy :-) Sad :- (Act Up! Play around! **Teri Burch** will have you stretching your imagination to improvise and modernize stories and plays; using your voice, characterization and movement exercises leading to the creation and performance of a short play.

HIP HOP DANCE: Learn the latest hip hop dance moves and styles, including popping and locking, glides, and breaking. Hip hop dance is a great opportunity for boys and girls of all ages to be creative, have fun, and learn to use their positive energy by moving to the latest beats!
